

You would like a herding demo for your event?

These are some of the questions you may be asked by the person you are approaching, so it pays to be prepared.

1. Date, length and location of your event?
2. Do you have a budget? You will need to budget for someone who can provide both the demo and the livestock.
3. How many days would you want demos for?
4. If your event is more than one day, can you accommodate livestock & handler & their dogs? Do you have onsite livestock facilities?
5. How many demos per day do you want? Of what length?
6. What type of area do you have for the demo? Size? Is it fenced? Type of fencing - page wire, board fence, temporary snow fence...?
7. Do you have a sound system? Does it have cordless/wireless ability? (Handheld Microphone/headset)
8. Does your event insurance cover this?

We request that you also include a statement that any responses should be sent to you via Direct Message. This will keep the conversation between you and the person you may potentially be working with and not on the Facebook page.
